Gerard Damiano was born in New York in 1964. He began drawing shortly thereafter. His medium of choice was his mother's lipstick which he prized for its ability to mark on any surface. He later studied illustration at the Rhode Island School of Design. After completing RISD's European Honors Program, he lived in Rome for 3 years. There he drew from the classical masterpieces of the ancient world. Upon returning to New York, he found work in the film and video industry.

In the early 1990's, he and his sister, the fire dancer Christar, embarked on an "Art Safari in America". Together they spent 4 years living in a mobile art studio, traveling extensively throughout the contiguous United States on a quest for truth and beauty. While touring the Pacific Northwest, Damiano experienced a shamanic awakening which transformed his life.

In 1997 he made his first journey to the Black Rock Desert of Nevada for "Burning Man", which he considers to be the most significant Art Event in the United States. Once there, he spontaneously became a Black Rock City Ranger. He learned from the Rangers the art of 'Bi-Locating', which is the ability to be in two places at once.

Today, Damiano lives in New York City, while simultaneously living in Ft. Myers, Florida with his sister, Christar.
