Uncontained: Fill the Void using recycled materials to make art!

Exhibiting: July 5-27, 2019

The unpredictability of found objects makes for the perfect opportunity for inspiration, so we're calling on you to transform trash into treasure for this recycled objects exhibit, *Uncontained*. Reuse, recycle, and reinterpret found materials into an impactful piece of art! Look locally for discarded materials, and use them to invent something new, unique, and sustainable.

### **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY FEE:**

An entry consists of 1 to 3 artworks. Non-refundable Entry Fee is \$20.00 for one entry and \$35.00 for 2 or 3 entries for Alliance for the Arts members - \$25.00 for one entry and \$45.00 for 2 or 3 entries for nonmembers. Alliance for the Arts memberships are \$55.00 and are good for one year.

### **DEADLINE FOR ENTRY:**

All entries must be submitted online no later than June 14. No materials will be accepted at the Alliance – this exhibit is online entries only. Upload digital images of artwork in JPG or PNG format. File size limit is 5MB. Please name files as follows: ARTIST- NAME-TITLE-MEDIUM-DIMENSIONS.JPG

### **AWARDS:**

\$250 for Best in Show, 2nd Place-\$125, 3rd Place-\$75

### **JUROR:** Dale Weber

Emerging as a young painter in the early 1970's, Dale Weber was invariably drawn to subjects that bore the passage of time with a quiet dignity. Switching from oil to acrylic to pastel to mixed media, he attempted to capture that intangible essence that lies just beneath the surface of a subject. In an attempt to define this elusive nature of the subject, he started to work with 'found objects' wherein the subject became the media itself. He has traveled this path for over twelve years recycling a variety of discarded materials. A veteran of both solo and invitational exhibits; a recipient of awards and critical acclaim, he continues the journey we all share as artists.

### **SPECIFICATIONS:**

We are asking artists to make artwork using recycled materials. Only original artwork will be accepted. No giclee or crafts. Categories include both 2D and 3D art. Other media can be used provided at least 75% is comprised of recycled materials.

All 2D artwork must be wired and ready to hang and not exceed six feet in any direction. All 3D artwork must not exceed six feet in any direction or 150 lbs.

## LIABILITY

If artwork is juried in, artists are responsible for all shipping costs. Every effort will be made to handle with care, including protection from loss. Alliance for the Arts will not be liable for loss or damage caused or occurring while work is exhibited or during shipping. Submission of any artwork constitutes an agreement to all conditions of this entry form, including schedule and permission to photograph for publicity purposes. Signature on the entry form is an agreement to these conditions.

## SALES

All submitted works selected for inclusion and display during this exhibition must be offered for sale to the public at a labeled price set by the artist. A 40% commission will be retained by the Alliance for the Arts on all work sold during the exhibition.
